

PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION COMMEMORATING THE 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ST. VRAIN AND LEFT HAND WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT IN LONGMONT, COLORADO

- WHEREAS, Municipal leaders, farmers, and visionaries petitioned the Court to create a water agency charged with improving water reliability and protecting the basin water supplies for future generations; and
- WHEREAS, in 1969 the City of Longmont leadership discussed creating a water conservancy district to construct a water project to meet municipal and basin demands; and
- WHEREAS, the St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District was organized as a water conservancy district by Court decree on April 19, 1971; and
- WHEREAS, in 1977 the Court approved the transfer of two reservoir filings from the City of Longmont to the St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District; and
- WHEREAS, in keeping with the 1971 formation decree, the St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District continues still today to promote the authorization and construction of water storage reservoirs for agriculture, municipal, and recreation uses as well as protecting basin water supplies, demonstrating fiscal responsibility, and assuming a leadership role in regional efforts to develop new water supplies; and
- WHEREAS, over the last 40 years the St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District successfully cooperated with local water agencies to enhance water management through financial contributions toward additional storage, and measuring and recording devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Bryan L. Baum, by virtue of the authority vested in me and the City Council of the City of Longmont, do hereby commemorate the 40th Anniversary of the St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District in Longmont.
